RULES/RESTRICTIONS

- Registration fees must be paid in cash or credit only. No checks accepted.
- **All hunters/teams must check in the night of the hunt.** Check-in will be at Reavis Drug, Pauls Valley, OK Friday, March 29, 5 pm - 8 pm.
- Must be at least 14 years of age to participate.
- Hunters may check in 3 hogs for heaviest weight (total weight of 3 for winning weight).
- No domestic or BAR hogs eligible.
- No OUT OF STATE KILLING of Hogs. All hogs must be killed in the state of Oklahoma.
- **No live hogs at weigh-in.**
- Hunters must check in separate hogs for the three side pots: one each of Biggest Boar, Biggest Sow & Longest Cutter (both cutters), measured from gumline to tip of cutter.
- Hunters may not reuse hogs for the three side pot categories (6 hogs must be checked in) with the exception of **MOST HOGS**. All hogs harvested are eligible for the Most Hogs Pot.
- No drone or helicopter hunting allowed; ground base hunting only.
- Night hunting/shooting allowed, but must abide by all Oklahoma Department of Wildlife and Department of Agriculture rules and regulations pertaining to Night Hunting/Shooting. (See <https://www.wildlifedepartment.com/hunting/> and <http://www.oda.state.ok.us/ais/feralswine.htm>)
- Landowner permission forms and associated Oklahoma Department of Wildlife/Department of Agriculture permits may be checked at weigh-in.
- All participants must adhere to all Oklahoma Department of Wildlife and Department of Agriculture regulations and laws related to feral hog hunting.
- Hunting begins Friday, March 29, 2019 at 8 pm and ends Saturday, March 30, at 8 pm.
 - Must be in line for weigh-in at 8 pm -- no exceptions.
- Teams must hunt together at all times.
- No hunting with other teams ("party hunting").
- No animal sharing or pooling. No trapping. No early hunting or penning of hogs.
- No hunting on high fence or commercial hunting areas. **Private lands only.**
- No dumping of hogs in city trash or private dumpsters. Hunters must take hogs with them after weigh-in and dispose of properly and legally. Any violations are subject to fines and disqualification from all future events.
- Pauls Valley Chamber and all sponsors are not responsible for any accidents or injuries. Contest is hunt at your own risk.
- NO REFUNDS.
- No alcohol or drug use permitted during hunt or weigh-in.
- By entering this contest and paying your fee, you are agreeing to the rules of the contest and Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Regulations. Hunters are subject to a polygraph test at the discretion of officials. Any violation of these rules will be grounds for immediate disqualification.
