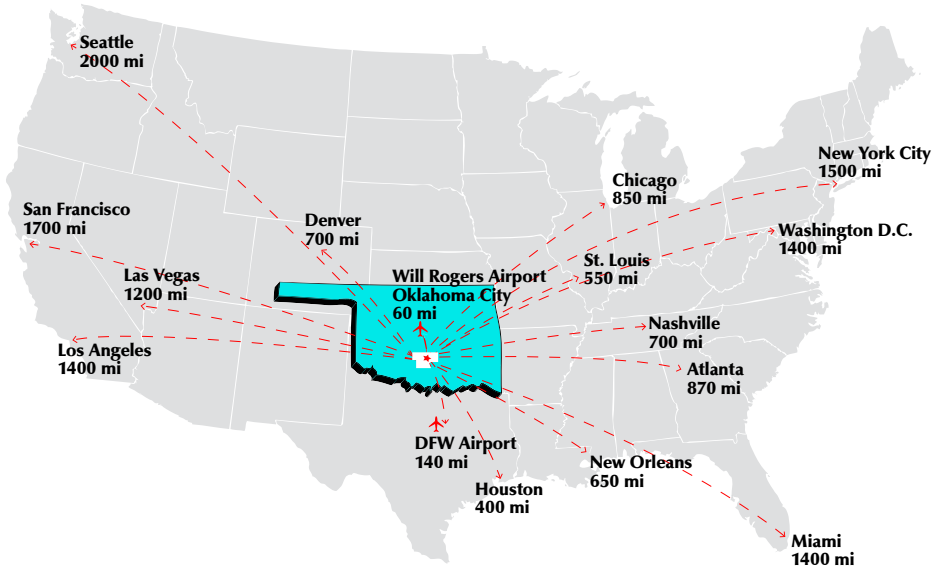


LIVING IN PAULS VALLEY

Pauls Valley, founded in 1857, is the county seat of Garvin County, Oklahoma. It is located 55 miles south of Oklahoma City and bounded on the west by Interstate 35 with the downtown section surrounding the intersection of U.S. Highway 77 and State Highway 19. Pauls Valley has a current population of 6,143. Garvin County's current population is 27,711.
